Physical education compulsory courses (0 credits): Starting from the 2013 academic year, bachelor's degree students must complete "Freshman Physical Education I" and "Freshman to Second-Year Interest Physical Education" and choose three subjects before graduation, for a total of 4 semesters of required physical education courses.
