Chung Yuan Christian University Regulations for Rewarding Students Participating in the Second Foreign Language Examination at the Department of Applied Linguistics and Language Studies

- Article 1 To encourage students of the Department of Applied Linguistics and Language Studies to enhance their second foreign language skills and improve their international competitiveness, these regulations are established.
- Article 2 Any student (including those in the master's program) who participates in any second foreign language examination during their enrollment and meets the required standards may apply for a reward. The application is based on the date the exam is taken and the date of the subsidy application. At the time of application, the student's enrollment status must be the same as it was during the exam. The reward items, standards, and amounts are as follows.

Article 3 Reward Standards:

- 1. Students who meet any of the following standards will receive a reward of NT\$2,000:
 - a. Japanese JLPT N2 pass
 - b. French DELF B1 pass (Taiwan French Cultural Association)
 - c. German Zertifikat Deutsch B1 level (Taipei Goethe-Institut)
 - d. Spanish DELE B1 level (Eurocentres Language Centre)
- 2. Students who meet any of the following standards will receive a reward of NT\$3,000:
 - a. Japanese JLPT N1 or higher pass
 - b. French DELF B2 or higher pass (Taiwan French Cultural Association)
 - c. German Zertifikat Deutsch B2 level (Taipei Goethe-Institut)
 - d. Spanish DELE B2 level (Eurocentres Language Centre)
- Article 4 To apply for the reward, students must prepare their student ID, exam score certificate (one original and one copy; the original will be verified and returned), and the exam payment receipt (original), and submit them to the department office. The reward is limited to one application per exam level.
- Article 5 The list of awardees will be published on the department's website.
- Article 6 Students who pass the second foreign language graduation threshold may receive a subsidy for half of the registration fee, but the availability of this subsidy depends on the teaching excellence program funding for the respective academic year.
- Article 7 These regulations are approved by the Department Affairs Meeting and will be trialed for three years.
