- ◆ The conference invites abstract of no more than 300 words in English for double-blind peer-reviews.
- ◆ Abstracts must be submitted via the conference website. Please prepare the following information and your abstract (in English) by adhering to the abstract format:
- ◆ The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- ◆ All abstracts will be published on the Conference website prior to the conference.

♦ Format:

- 1). Title of the paper
- 2). A 50-word short abstract (for publication in the conference program)
- 3). A 300-word extended abstract (for blind peer review)
- 4). 3-5 keywords
