Dr. Neil J Anderson is a Professor in the MA TESOL program in the Department of Linguistics and English Language at Brigham Young University, Provo, Utah. He also serves as the Coordinator at the English Language Center. Neil has taught and presented papers and workshops in over 40 countries. His research interests include second language reading, motivation, language learning strategies, and teacher leadership. He is the author of a teacher education text entitled *Exploring Second Language Reading: Issues and Strategies* (1999, Heinle) and an EFL reading series *ACTIVE Skills for Reading* (2012, Heinle). Neil served as President of Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages, Inc. 2001-2002. He has had two Fulbright research/teaching fellowships, one in Costa Rica (2002-2003) and in Guatemala (2009-2010).
